APPELLATION D'ORIGINE PROTÉGÉE

Benefiting from a very favorable climate, Pierrevert is at the heart of the Appellation d'origine contrôlée (AOC), which covers 450 hectares of vineyards, located on the sunny slopes of the hills and plains surrounding the Durance river. The area surrounding this small village is an enchanting location producing exceptionally refined wines which bring the winetasting experience to new heights.

INDICATION GÉOGRAPHIQUE PROTÉGÉE



Granted by the European Union, the Protected Geographical Indication (PGI) covers the entire department of Alpes-de-Haute-Provence. This rugged terrain encompasses a variety of landscapes and climates, from the lush Durance valley to the arid Plateau of Valensole. Truly Provençal at heart, these red, white, and rosé wines will delight oenophiles with their wide array of aromas.

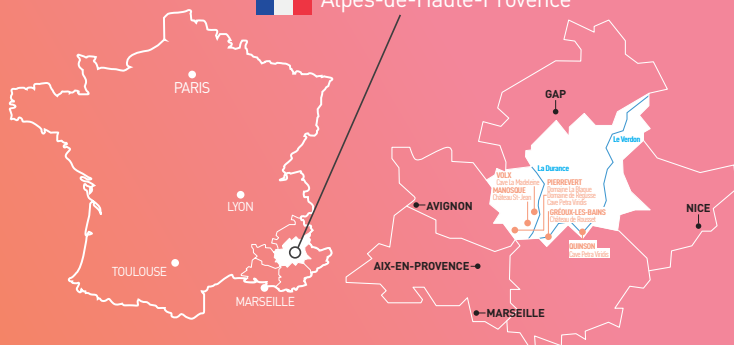

WINES irresistibles!

The local white wines have complex aromatic profiles and a characteristic freshness, whose subtle citrus flavors are unexpected with such a pale yellow color.

The rosés are surprisingly fresh and fruity, offering a roundness rich with notes of red berries.

The reds have an appealing deep color with subtle hints of purple. Thanks to high anthocyanin content and a subtle tannic structure, they are perfectly paired with local specialties, such as Banon cheese or Sisteron lamb.
